The Everest Base Camp helicopter tour with landing also presents jaw-dropping views of many other mountains like Kanchenjunga (8,586 m/28,169 ft), Lhotse (8,516 m/27,940 ft), Makalu (8,463 m/27,766 ft), Cho Oyu (8,188 m/26,864 ft), Nuptse (7,861 m/25,791 ft), Ama Dablam (6,812 m/22,349 ft), Thamserku (6,608 m/21,680 ft), etc.

Is there an altitude sickness risk during the Everest Base Camp helicopter tour with landing?

No, there is no altitude sickness risk during the Everest Base Camp helicopter tour because you will not spend a lot of time in the mountains. At Kala Patthar, you will land for only 5 minutes to soak in the views, and at Hotel Everest View, you will have around 30 minutes to have breakfast.

Likewise, you will land in Lukla airport twice for 15 minutes to refuel the chopper. Given this short duration, participants do not see altitude sickness symptoms. We highly recommend you to not spend more than 5 minutes at Kala Patthar because the altitude sickness can kick in quite fast.

The Hotel Everest View is a luxury lodge in the Khumbu region and also one of the highest hotels in the world. It is situated at 3,962 meters (13,000 ft) from sea level. After exploring Kala Patthar, you will descend to Syangboche Airstipr and walk from here to the Hotel Everest View, which takes only a few minutes.

You will have around 1 hour to enjoy breakfast as per your choice, with a view of Mt. Everest, Mt. Lhotse, Mt. Nuptse, and Mt. Ama Dbla. The breakfast expenses are not covered in our Everest Base Camp helicopter tour cost, so carry money/card for it. You can buy anything as per your budget.

Given the short length of the Everest base camp helicopter flight, this is the best way to take a quick break from your daily routine and unwind. The trip does not demand any lofty effort, whether it comes to preparing or traveling itself.

The helicopter takes off, offering stunning mountain views of the distant and wonderful aerial panorama of Kathmandu. You will reach Lukla in 45 minutes of flying. Land at Lukla airport and refuel the chopper. From here, you will fly to the Everest Base Camp.

Witness the breathtaking aerial panorama of the Khumbu Glacier Khumbu Icefall. Witness numerous mountains like Thamsekru, Ama Dablam, Lhotse, Nuptse, Everest, Makalu, Kanchenjunga, Pumori, CHolatse, etc. Likewise, the aerial view of the villages, forests, valleys, and rivers is excellent too.

Before returning, you will land at Kala Patthar for 5 minutes and fly to the Hotel Everest View. Have breakfast and continue the flight to Lukla. Refuel the chopper and fly back to Kathmandu. Kindly drop your review before going back to your hotel. You will also receive the tour completion certificate.
