Pashupatinath temple is a popular place for Hindus, dedicated to Lord Shiva, with beautiful stone and wooden carved sculptures. Boudhanath Stupa is one of the biggest stupas in the world. Kathmandu Durbar Square is an open museum with remarkable religious sculptures. The goddess Kumari is another attraction here. Patan Durbar Square is dedicated to Lord Krishna



and its art gallery is great to explore.
