The freedom to explore at your pace is one of the best parts about going on a private jeep tour. You may want to stop for a while, enjoy the views, take some pictures, or visit hidden cultural sites, which is very easy if you're travelling in a private jeep. During your trip, you will be treated to panoramic views of Annapurna, Dhaulagiri, Nilgiri, and a host of other peaks of the Himalayas. The road is mostly off-road and rugged, making the adventure even more



thrilling.

Day to Day Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival at Tribhuvan-International airport - Kathmandu (Elevation 1350 m).

Day 02: Drive to Pokhara (Elevation 820 m).

Day 03: Drive Pokhara to Beni to Tatopani (Elevation 2600 m).

Day 04: Drive from Tatopani to Kagbeni (2900m. Elevation) and visit Muktinath Temple (Elevation 3800 m.)

Day 05: After official formalities of Special permit we drive to Ghami Village (3520 m. Elevation) Via Syngboche Pass (Elevation 4200 m.).

Day 06: Drive to Lo-Mangthang (Elevation 3840 m.)

Day 07: Exploration day in Lo-Manthang and Chhosar.

Day 08: Drive back to Jomsom (Elevation 2743 m.)

Day 09: Drive to Pokhara (Elevation 820m.)

Day 10: Drive/Fly back to Kathmandu (Elevation 1350m.)

Day 11: Final departure from Kathmandu.
